3.4	Division of Wildlife Resources Proposed Land Acquisition Near the Great Salt Lake	The State of Utah Division of Wildlife Resources is currently working on a potential land purchase in Salt Lake County, and as part of their statutory responsibilities are required to present projects to the county council.

4.1	Declaration of Donations: Dimple Dell Preservation Committee	The Dimple Dell Preservation Committee obtained the following grants and donations that need to be reviewed by Council: A \$50,000 grant from the Utah Department of Cultural and Community Engagement for the purpose of architectural work on the restoration of the Muir-Poulsen Farmhouse. \$25,000: \$15,000 donation from the Alvin E. Malstrom Foundation and a \$10,000 reimbursable grant from the Utah State Office of Outdoor Recreation for the purpose of creating an outdoor classroom.
4.2	Salt Lake County Noxious Weed Control Board Appointment Appointment: Laura Flower	The noxious weed board is a 5-member board consisting of 2 farmers, or persons involved in production agriculture. Laura Flower meets this requirement as she is involved in production agriculture through her position overseeing Merit Medical employee garden. Her knowledge and expertise of pollinator plants, farming, greenhouse production, and community outreach and partnership development within the refugee farming community in Salt Lake is valuable to the weed board. Laura's perspective as a woman, having worked with diverse communities in farming, we feel would be a great benefit to our goal of creating a diverse Salt Lake County board
4.3	Salt Lake County Noxious Weed Control Board RE-Appointment RE-Appointment: Ron Jones	The noxious weed board is a 5-member board consisting of 2 farmers, or persons involved in production agriculture. Ron Jones has served previous terms and is one of the few wheat farmers left in Salt Lake County. His knowledge and expertise of are farming over many decades on the southwest part of the Salt Lake Valley are valuable to the weed board. As it is very difficult to find busy farmers to volunteer their time in the weed board, we appreciate his time and willingness to serve a 2nd term
4.4	Consideration of Fee Addition In the Amount of \$45 for Trichmoniasis testing to the Salt Lake County Health Department Clinical Services Fee Schedule	The Salt Lake County Health Department Clinical Services agency requests Council approval to add a \$45 fee for a new Trichomoniasis test that is available to the current fee schedule. This is a test that many patients ask for and can get at other labs but not at our clinic. The test that the state lab is providing may be used for women and men. Providing the test makes us a more comprehensive STD testing clinic. It will pick up trich in patients with or without symptoms. We will be able to test those patients that are a contact to trich, (male or female). It will decrease the amount of unnecessary antibiotic treatment. The fee we are requesting be added to the schedule will is \$45- It will include the \$35 for our test, and a \$10 administration fee.
