Yesterday, I delivered my annual State of the County address at the South Jordan Recreation Center.

I remain committed to **lowering costs for tax payers** while **improving the delivery of county services**. This commitment has yielded significant new investments in parks, trails, and other opportunities for county residents.

I am committed to working across party lines to keep taxes low without compromising the nationally recognized and award-winning services our community deserves.

Accomplishments from 2023

 Creation of the My County Rec Pass Plan, providing free passes to Salt Lake County kids ages 5-18 starting this summer

- Opening of the 142-mile first phase of the Butterfield Canyon trail system
- Opening of the first 45-acres of the Bingham Creek Regional Park in South Jordan
- Maintaining Salt Lake's position in the top 1% of counties nationwide for fiscal management by preserving our Triple A bond rating from every major credit agency
- Strengthening of Salt Lake County's diversified economy, with a 2.6% unemployment rate, among the lowest in the nation

Challenges and Priorities for 2024

"Our future is bright, but we must continue to recognize that families throughout our county still face challenges. Inflation and high housing costs are real pressures"

- Efforts to **provide shelter, mental health services**, and support for the county's homeless residents
- Investments totaling \$25 million in 17 new projects that will produce
 1,500 affordable housing units
- Ensuring the changes to the Unified Policing District do not compromise the effective and responsive law enforcement our resident have come to expect
- Reforming the criminal justice system in Salt Lake County to prioritize early evidence-based, cost-effective interventions that divert lowlevel, non-violent offenders into treatment centers
