They then organize a meeting and service project that focuses on that advocacy issue. Past topics have included air pollution, suicide prevention, refugee outreach, homelessness, accessibility, transportation, the Great Salt Lake, and more. This year, our newly elected officials will tackle topics including book bans, airsoft gun usage in County parks, and teen vaping.


