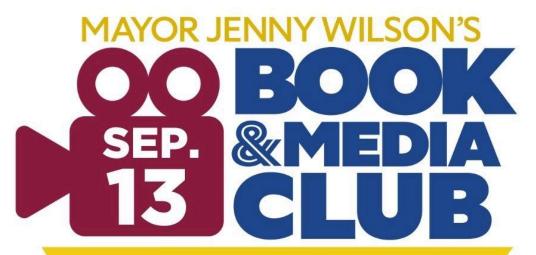
Love Your Enemies
