Foothill Residential *

Density is generally less than one dwelling units per 2.5 acres or larger. Properties with no development potential should remain in it's natural state.

Neighborhood/Planned Community Residential

Residential developments with a base density of 3 units per acre. Density of up to 5 units per acre is allowable for large scale master-planned communities.

Low Density Residential

Residential developments with a base density of 2.5 units per acre. Density bonuses allowing up to 4 units per acre are allowed for subdivision design which incorporates open space, community space, or other goals of the Southwest Community Plan.

Mountain Residential

Density is generally less than one dwelling units per 5 acres and in some locations as little as one 1 dwelling unit per 20 acres. Properties with no development potential should remain in it's natural state.
