Staff will get clarification from the Haven on how they calculated the number of clients to be served, and to elaborate on which programs they work closely with and how.  Staff will clarify from the Odyssey House why the HVAC is inadequate & what lifetime services for residences include. Also, clarify where the \$75,000 in other funds are coming from.  Staff will clarify how the numbers were obtained from Project Realty in regards to the amount requested, and is it the City or County code they must comply with and who enforces this.
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
